When contacting the physician's office personnel, explain your circumstances and determine the doctor's criteria for accepting new patients.

Information to have ready:

- Insurance Coverage
- Specific family health conditions
- Ages family members to be included

Questions you may want to ask:

- Will the doctor request an interview with a family member prior to acceptance?
- Will the doctor send monthly statement or are payments due at the time of each office visit?
- Will the doctor accept patients receiving Title 19 or other subsidized programs?
- Will the doctor allow his/her patients to select consultants for specialized services

A good time to choose a primary care physician is while you or your family enjoys good health. This gives you an opportunity to select a physician most suited to your needs. (A primary care physician is one who will assume responsibility for advising you on all your medical needs; those specialties generally regarded as involved in primary care are: family practice, pediatrics, obstetrics/gynecology, and internal medicine). The primary care physician serves as your coordinator for the use of other medical consultants or facilities as the need arises.
